### Beginning Cane Making Materials List

#### Pasta Machine **Must Have**

Acrylic Rod or Acrylic Brayer (best)  
Smooth work surface (tile, marble, tempered glass or acrylic sheet)  
Tissue or “clay” blade  
Saran or Waxed Paper  
Shoe box lid or similar container for transporting canes home  
Ruler or Tape Measure

Clay colors of your choice (Kato or leached Primo) plus white and black. Bring extra white as it is used a lot. Read the package.....make sure it is NOT translucent, flesh, or metallic.

### Polymer and Macramé Closure Bracelet

#### **MUST HAVE: Pasta Machine**

Work surface  
3 colors of clay, Kato or leached Primo. You will need some contrast such as white, blue, gold. If you are uncertain, email me for suggestions.  
Shade-text sheet (the one used for the sample is called “Tile” from the Architecture Set #SAA4) Mail order.....or, from Michaels or Kit Kraft, Makin’s Clay set “B” “dot” or “C” “honeycomb”  
Set of 5 Kemper square cutters  
Saran wrap  
Very sharp **flexible** clay blade  
Needle tool  
Water spritzer  
Ruler  
Scissors  
Conso cord. I will have black, green, brown and red available. If you want other colors, email me as to where to buy it.  
Beads to put between the polymer beads on your bracelet, and 2 for the ends. (see sample for ideas) “E” beads, 4mm glass and seed beads are good choices  
Masking tape
